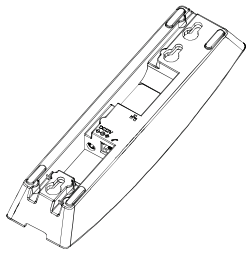


Unpacking

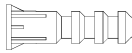
Before using the device, check the device model and ensure that the shipped box includes the following items:



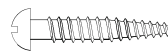
Handset X 1

Plastic wall anchor X 2

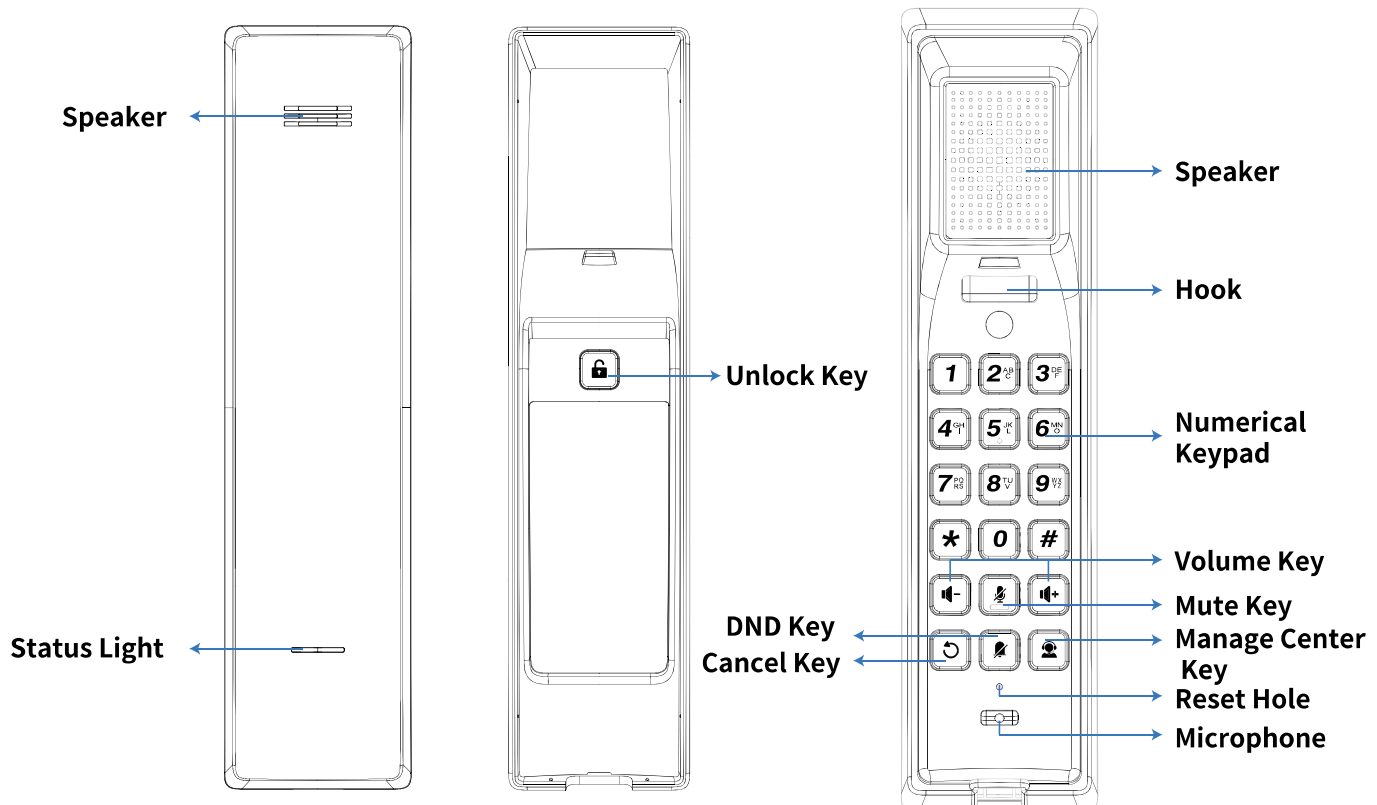


Plastic wall anchor X 2

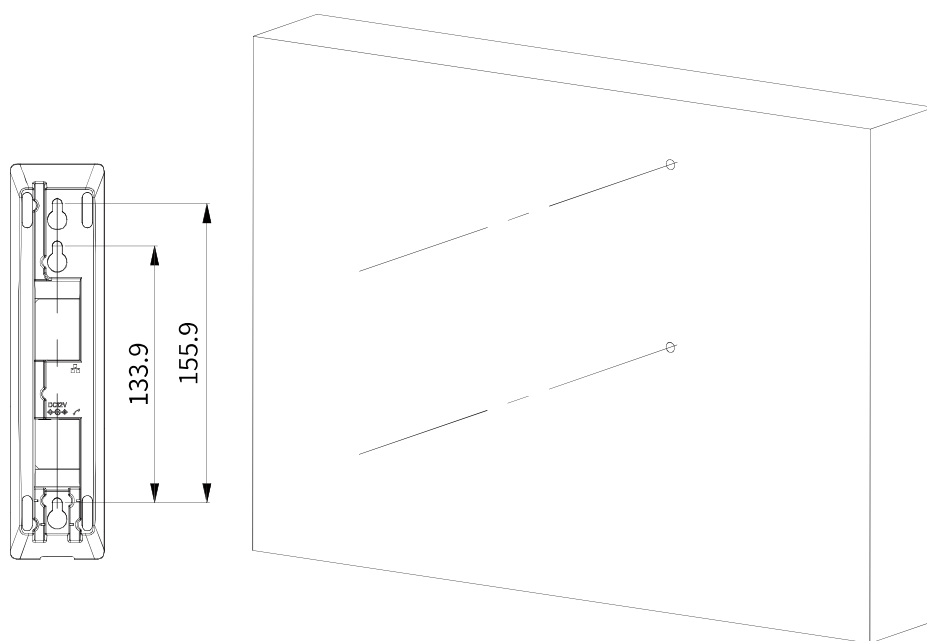


Phone cord X 1

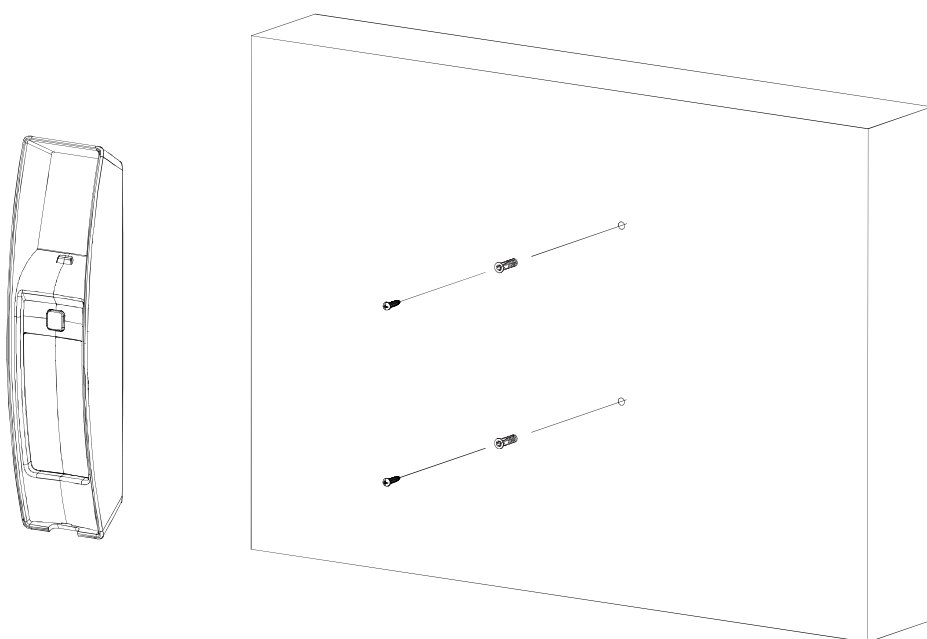

Installation



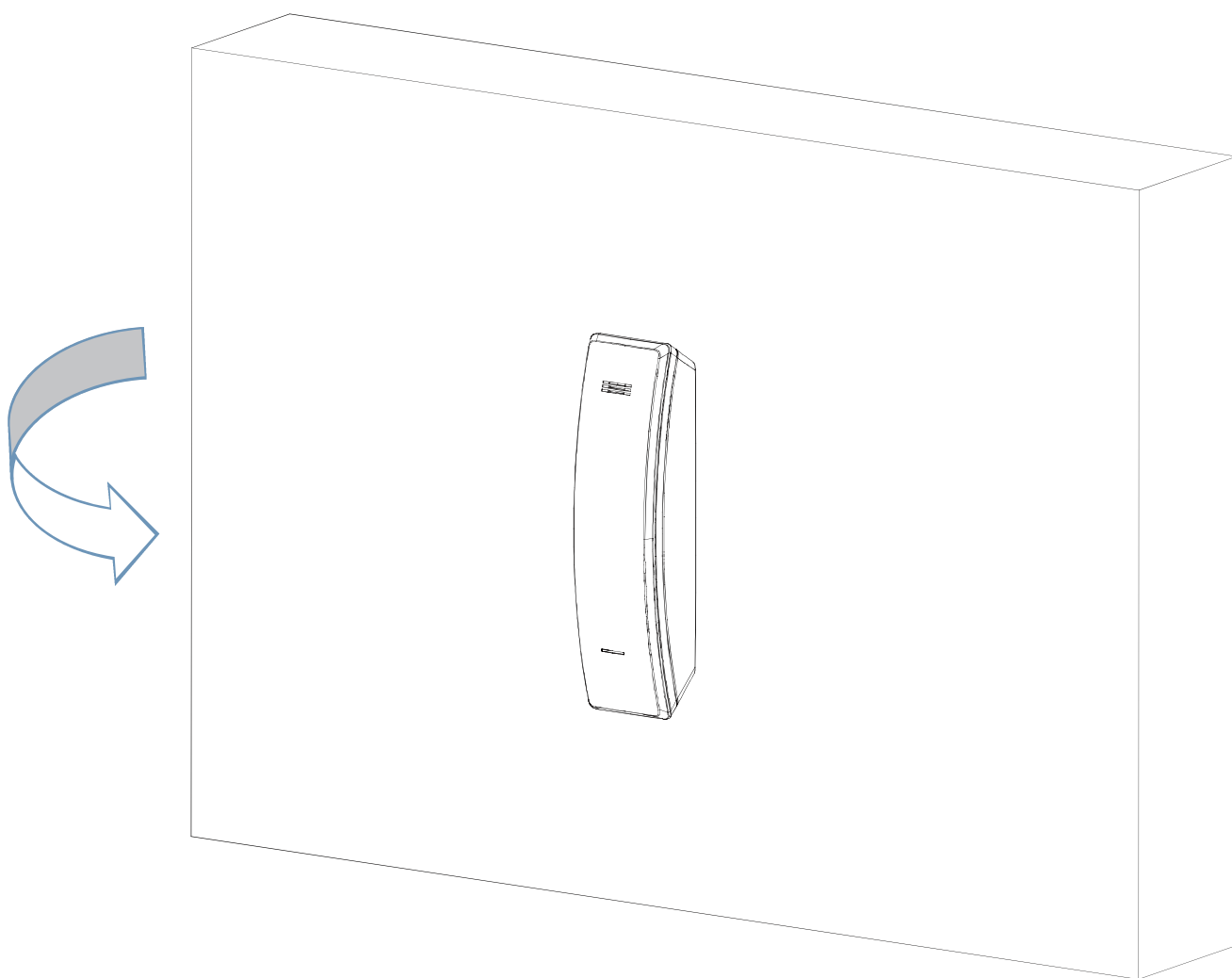
According to the position of cable, drill two holes in the wall, and make sure the distance between these two holes matches the measurement indicated on the figure.



Insert plastic wall anchors into drilled holes.

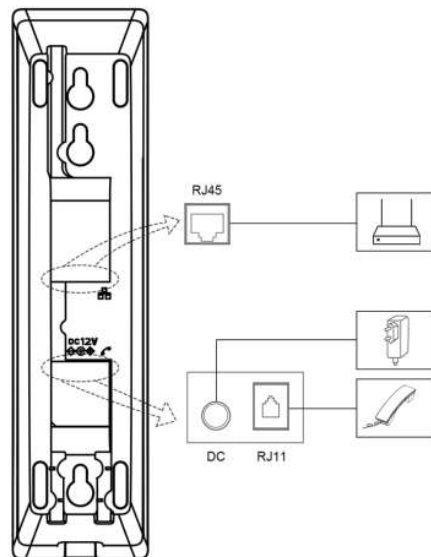
Turn ST4x20 crosshead screws into plastic wall anchors. Do not fully tighten the screws, and leave some space for placing devices.

Connect cables to corresponding interface to test device. For further details, see “Device Wiring” section.

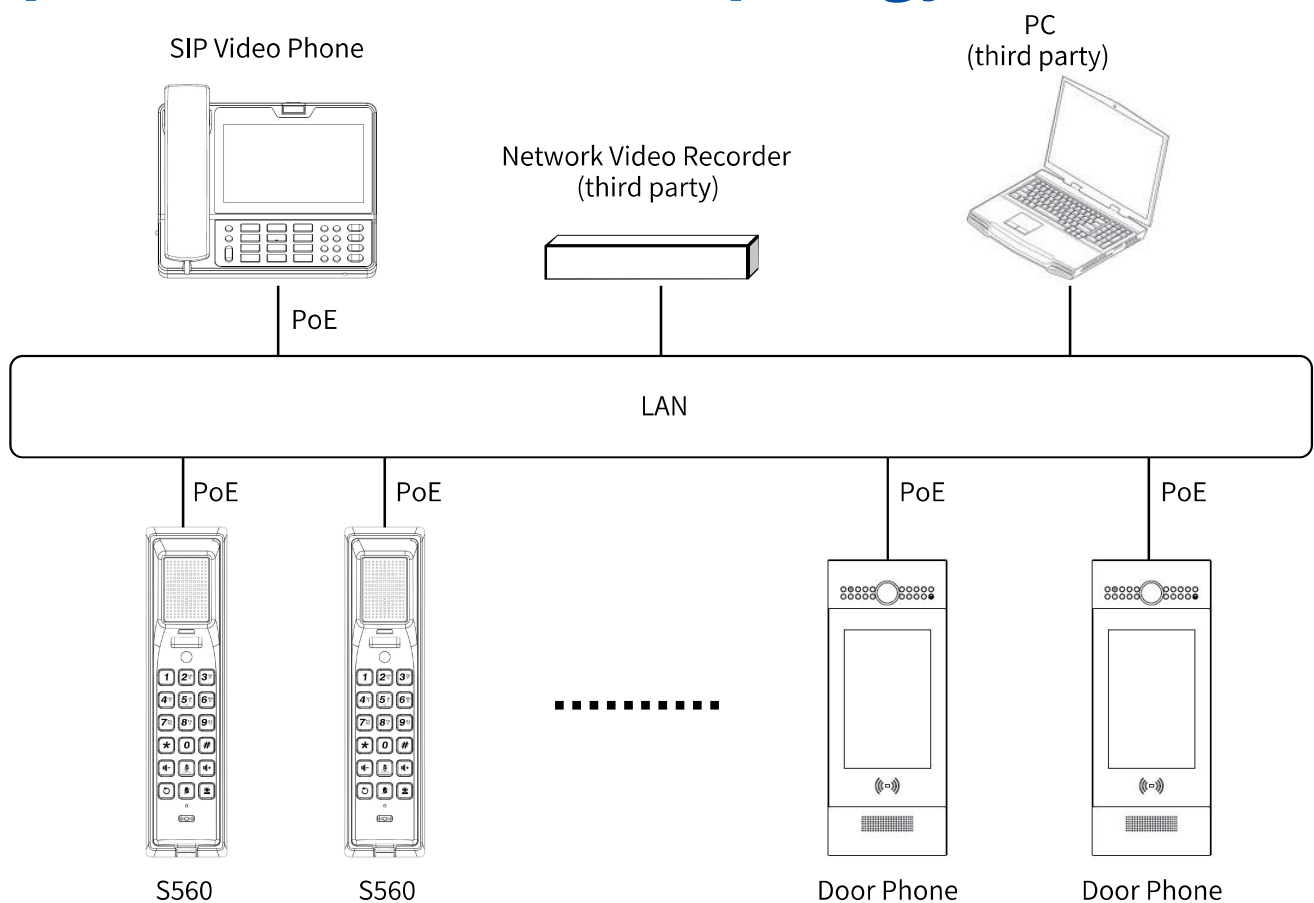


Match up the screw holes with the screws, and then press down the device to attach device securely to the wall.

Configuration

1. Access the Website: Press and hold **#** button, the device will announce IP address. Type in the IP address in browser, then enter the username and password to login (both of them are 'admin' by default).
2. Access basic information: After setting up network and power, enter **Status > Basic** to check Account, Network, Version status.
3. Account Registration: On web UI, go to the path: **Account > Basic** page to fill in the account information, click **Submit** to confirm (please refer to Administrator Guide for more information).

Operation

Make a call

Enter the callee's number or room address to make a audio call.

Unlock

During the talk, you can press **Unlock**  **icon** on the talking interface to unlock the door.

Speed dial

Long press pre-configured key button for 1 second to make a call.

Do Not Disturb (DND)

In the DND mode, the status light is always on in purple.
